



WINTER POWDER HORN 2017 –

It is time to start preparing for Winter Powder Horn 2017. Winter Powder Horn is designed for Venturer's and Older Boy Patrols in the BSA along with their Adult Leaders and Advisers. Powder Horn provides a High Adventure filled extended weekend course to sample High Adventure Activities and the Resources available to pull off High Adventures with your Crew or Unit.

This Winters High Adventure Resource Course will experience;

• Skiing and Boarding	• Snowmobiling / ATV	• Snow Shoeing / Cross Country Skiing
• Ice Boating	• Shooting Sports	• Equestrian
• Tubing	• Caving	• SCUBA
• Snow Biking	• Climbing / Repelling	• Yes there is more, much more

The course will run from February 18th – 20th of 2017. The Cost for the course is \$185 for early registration and then \$200 after early registration ends on October 31, 2016. Late Registration is \$225 which begins on January 1, 2017. Registration will include all adventures, meals, lodging, your Powder Horn Medallion which is the only award that adults may wear on the left pocket of your Field Uniform. You will also receive your very own Powder Horn Stormy Kromer Hat and collectors patch as part of the course. Please include your hat size when registering. (see back page for sizing chart)

Powder Horn is open to adults and youth 14 years of age and over who have permission from their unit leader and have completed the required trainings for their position. In addition, all participants must complete and be currently certified at the time of the course for Trek On Safely and Hazardous Weather. All participants 18 and over must complete Venturing Youth Protection Training prior to taking the course. It is highly recommended prior to taking Powder Horn that you successfully complete OKPIK Training.

Indoor overnight facilities have been provided for the entire course. For those cold weather OKPIKians, you may also camp outdoors if you so desire. The Main Building at Camp Peacock will be always open during the course if you need warmth or shelter. Base Camp will be at Camp Peacock in Lake Villa.

You cannot not experience more fun filled High Adventure in one course than with Powder Horn. The course is limited to 48 participants so register early to ensure space and a reduced Powder Horn participation rate. The course will start promptly at 8:00 AM on Saturday February 18, 2017 and run through mid-day February 20th ending with the graduation ceremony.

STORMY KROMER CAP SIZE CHART



To get your size, measure around the largest part of your head, above the eyebrows, with a tape measure. Take that number of inches and divide by 3.14 or pi. That number is your hat size. If you are between sizes, always round up to the nearest 1/8th inch.
